

**JOINT MEETING OF CBFA AND GWAV
November 13-14, 2010
Wheeling, West Virginia**

The joint meeting of CBFA and GWAV will begin on Saturday, November 13, 2010, at the West Virginia Independence Hall Museum, located at the corner of 16th and Market Streets (1528 Market St.) From I-70 take exit 1A South on Main St. to 16th, turn left and go one block. Parking is available behind the building.

On Sunday, November 14, the museum is closed so we will meet in the Colonnade Room at the conference hotel, the McClure Hotel at 1200 Market St., just a short walk from the museum. The hotel has reserved some rooms for us for \$79 for a double, and \$89 for a king, plus tax. (King rooms have microwaves and refrigerators.) We recommend that you make your reservation by early October at 304-232-0300. Mention Great Waters Association of Vexillology when you make your reservation.

We urge you to consider giving a presentation at the conference so we will have some interesting talks, in a format of about 30 minutes maximum. A formal paper is welcome, but not required.
